Dear Members of the Tribunal,

Canada writes pursuant to the Tribunal's communication of May 18, 2021 regarding the Claimant's e-mail of May 14, 2021 and inviting Canada to provide any comments it may have.

Canada acknowledges the Tribunal's ruling in Procedural Order No. 12 regarding the confidentiality designations to exhibit C-108 and the *Mesa Power* videos. With respect to the *Mesa Power* videos, Canada is proceeding with the Tribunal's direction to propose confidential information designations to the Claimant and to follow the procedures set out in the Confidentiality Order in this regard. With respect to exhibit C-108, in light of the Tribunal's final determination that it does not contain confidential information, Canada formally withdraws its proposed confidentiality designations to this exhibit.
